Dear Family Members and Friends,

All visitors will continue to be pre-screened through the dedicated COVID-19 questionnaire and temperature reading through the facial recognition system. Visitors must have a negative COVID-19 test prior to their visit, or the facility will provide a rapid Covid-19 test kit.

For visitors who visit for multiple days, including a visitor who comes every day, proof of negative testing is required as often as feasible, at a minimum every third day (meaning at a minimum testing is required on day one, day 4, day 7, and so on).

Visitation Hours and Locations

Recommended visiting hours is between 9:00AM and 8:00PM, seven days a week. Accommodations will be made to facilitate visitation outside of the recommended hours.

Visits may take place in resident rooms and day room spaces throughout the facility. In addition, there are two courtyards, Essex and Tate that will be open during visitation hours. Courtyards will be closed during inclement weather.

Visitors must continue to wear a mask in all areas of the building and adhere to infection control practices. Visitors must inform the facility if they have tested positive for Covid-19 so that the facility can begin contact tracing to minimize the exposure.

Visitation hours, days and locations, number of visitors are subject to change in the event of an outbreak.
